We will keep you updated with what malaria IEC materials for ethnic groups each country has developed.





WAR AGAINST III 1 thought they understood what 1 told them about GET I Malaria prevention. Dops! it still needs more work.




















Bednets prevent Halaria. I try to remind everyone to use a beduet every night. They listen to me well.
